Noah wasn't **sinless** but he **habitually chose to obey** God.

The Hebrew word for "violent brutality" is "HAMAS."

God decided to partially undo His creation to start over.

Noah's ark project was an amazing demonstration of faith!

All land-dwelling creatures not on the ark would die.

Plants would regrow from **roots** or **seeds**.

God introduces the covenant He'd formalize in Genesis 9.

Seven pairs of "clean" animals needed for use as sacrifices.

Couldn't leave ark until about **200 days after peak** of flood.

Noah "did everything" & "did all" that God asked.

Enoch & Noah both "walked with God."

Faith is credited as righteousness (Romans 4:9)
